

Audition Directions

Most kid castings are used to get a sense of your child's personality and their ability to follow directions. Kids are rarely asked to memorize a script. We recommend only taping once, rather than doing multiple takes. Mistakes are ok for kids! We would rather see an honest reaction than one that is overly rehearsed.

Please film your child so that the camera is zoomed from head to waist. Sit behind your camera or directly next to it so that your child is looking at or near the camera.

Ask your child the following questions and give them as much time as they'd like to answer.

1. What is your name?
2. How old are you?
3. What is your favorite movie/tv show/book? (You know your child best, what will they be excited to talk about?)
4. Tell me about your family.
5. What is the best part about school/daycare?
6. What do you do to have the most fun ever?
